Regulations for the use of guest rooms in student dormitories, in the Academic House and in the Collegium Physicum Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań

§1. General provisions

- 1. Guest rooms located in student dormitories, the Academic House and the Collegium Physicum of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań (hereinafter referred to as "AMU") may be used for short-term accommodation of guests of students, doctoral students, AMU employees and other persons with the consent of the administration of the given facility.
- 2. Use of the guest room requires prior reservation and acceptance of these regulations.
- 3. AMU reserves the right to refuse accommodation to a person who has not complied with these regulations in the past.

§2. Reservation and fees

- 1. Room reservations are made through the administration of the each facility.
- 2. The fee for the stay is charged according with the applicable price list.
- 3. The fee must be paid in advance, no later than on the day of arrival.
- 4. The hotel day lasts from 1:00 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. the following day.

§3. Rules of stay

- 1. The guest is obligated to:
 - 1) comply with the night silence between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.,
 - 2) maintaining order in the room and common areas,
 - 3) respect the property of AMU and other guests.
- 2. It is prohibited to:
 - 1) bringing in other people without the consent of the administration of the facility,
 - 2) drinking alcohol and using narcotics,
 - 3) disturbing the order and peace of other residents.
 - 4) smoking cigarettes and using open fire indoors,
 - 5) staying with animals

§4. Liability

- 1. The guest bears full financial responsibility for any damage caused to the room and common areas.
- 2. In the event of a gross violation of the regulations, AMU reserves the right to immediately terminate the stay, without the right to a refund.

§5. Final provisions

1. Accommodation in a given facility is equivalent to acceptance of these regulations.
